

Orthodontics - Osteopathy or the indispensable collaboration in the management of dento-skeletal asymmetries

Asymmetries in the lower part of the face often lead to functional asymmetries or asymmetries in manducatory and phonatory movements. Correcting dento-skeletal asymmetries requires the joint management of chronic tensions and contractures of the surrounding muscles, which are just as asymmetrical. The osteopath works on joints, muscles and tendons. His/her intervention is an integral part of my treatment plans for dento-skeletal asymmetries.

Sensory-motor rehabilitation of lingual dysfunctions: what you need to know

The involvement of lingual dysfunctions in cervico-maxillo-facial pathologies is recognized by most functional therapists. In recent years, there has been growing interest in alternative therapies, notably myofunctional therapies (physiotherapy, speech therapy, etc.). An explanatory model of lingual function that takes account of neuro-physiological specificities, functional referents and dependencies will enable more specific sensory-motor approaches to be developed.

Growth of the orofacial sphere is the result of genetic and congenital factors, as well as functional (breathing, sucking, swallowing, chewing, etc.) and environmental stimuli. Speech therapists and osteopaths can offer invaluable help to ensure that this important phase of the first 1,000 days of life runs smoothly. For the benefit of our young patients, we work together to support breastfeeding, mobility of the cervico-maxillo-facial structures, management of pediatric feeding disorders, support for the cessation of parafunctions and stimulation of nasal breathing.
